Rails and Sleepers - These fish belly rails and stone sleepers show how the first tracks would have looked. Why do you think they are called 'fish belly' rails?



Steam in a Can - This was a souvenir produced for the 150th anniversary in 1975. Can you spot three other souvenirs from different celebrations around the museum?

Derwent - The oldest surviving Darlington built locomotive. Can you find when and where it was built?
